

Creating Your FSA ID

An FSA ID is a username and password that you must use to log in to certain U.S. Department of Education (ED) websites. Your FSA ID identifies you as someone who has the right to access your own personal information on ED websites such as the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®)* at fafsa.gov.


If you are a parent of a **dependent student**, you will need your own FSA ID if you want to sign your child's FAFSA electronically. If you have more than one child attending college, you can use the same FSA ID to sign all applications. *Please note: Each FSA ID user must have a unique e-mail address.*

Your FSA ID is used to sign legally binding documents electronically. It has the same legal status as a written signature. **Don't give your FSA ID to anyone—not even to someone helping you fill out the FAFSA.** Sharing your FSA ID could put you at risk of [identity theft!](#)

Page ONE

1. Enter your personal email address that you check regularly!
***Students – DO NOT use your OLCHS email – this is not permanent and will not be accessible after you graduate!

2. Create a username. It is a good idea to just use the first part of your email before the “@” symbol.
Example: If my email is Sparty2016@olchs.com then my username would be Sparty2016

3. Create a password between 8-30 characters long. It must contain the following:
 - a. Lowercase letter
 - b. Uppercase letter
 - c. A number
 - d. A special character (examples: * # ^ _ %)

4. Certify that you are at least 13 years old, then hit “Continue.”

5. Enter your Social Security Number: _____ - _____ - _____
6. Enter your birthdate in the following format: MM/DD/YYYY (Example: 01/20/2001)
7. Enter your FULL LEGAL name as it appears on your birth certificate. Do not use abbreviations or nicknames!
8. Enter your full mailing address and phone number (without dashes).
9. Check your language preference, then hit "Continue."

*****NOTE** - Pay attention to your use of capital letters – when you return you must enter your answers EXACTLY as you did when creating your FSA ID!



Page FOUR – Review & Confirm

*****NOTE** – Make sure you check the box at the bottom to accept the terms and conditions before you hit "Continue."

Step FIVE – Confirmations

1. Verify your cell phone by entering the code sent via text.
2. Check your email for a numeric code and enter it in this screen
*****NOTE** – you must do this within 15 minutes or the code will expire!!



Once you have confirmed your cell phone and email, your FSA ID is ready to use!
