Although students are encouraged to take full advantage of the traditional four-year high school program, arrangements may be made to graduate in less than four years. If a student plans to graduate in less than four years, this *Early Graduation Request Form* must be submitted to the student’s counselor **no later than March 10, 2025**. Students graduating in less than four years must meet all graduation requirements including credit requirements (44 credits), 24 hours of service learning and FAFSA completion/opt out before they will be issued a letter of graduation. The letter of graduation is required to attend college during Semester 2 or prove completion of requirements to an employer. Diplomas are only issued after the graduation ceremony in May and all graduation requirements have been met.

The four-year physical education requirement is waived for the early graduate. **NOTE: If a student elects to remain in school after meeting early graduation requirements, or is unable to graduate early as expected, the student must earn all applicable physical education credits and be enrolled in a minimum of 5 classes to be eligible to graduate.** A student is not considered a graduate unless all graduation requirements are met by the end of the semester in which the student intends to graduate. Therefore, if a student does not graduate early as anticipated, all physical education credits must be earned.

Students planning to graduate in less than four years should be cautioned regarding several matters:

- Students that intend on entrance into higher education programs should be aware of the necessary college or university requirements. For example, some colleges and universities require four years of English, etc.
- Students graduating early should realize that some scholarship opportunities may not be available due to early graduation.
- Students graduating early should apply for college financial aid during spring semester of their junior year. Students are encouraged to meet with their counselors with questions regarding the FAFSA.
- Students graduating early are not eligible for graduation honors; including Outstanding Senior.
- Students graduating early are encouraged to enroll in dual credit coursework. Early graduates who enroll in AP courses must commit to returning for the AP exam(s) in May.
