District uses Microsoft Single Sign-on (SSO) for the applications below. Once initially logged in with the proper credentials, you will be able to use SSO for future logins.

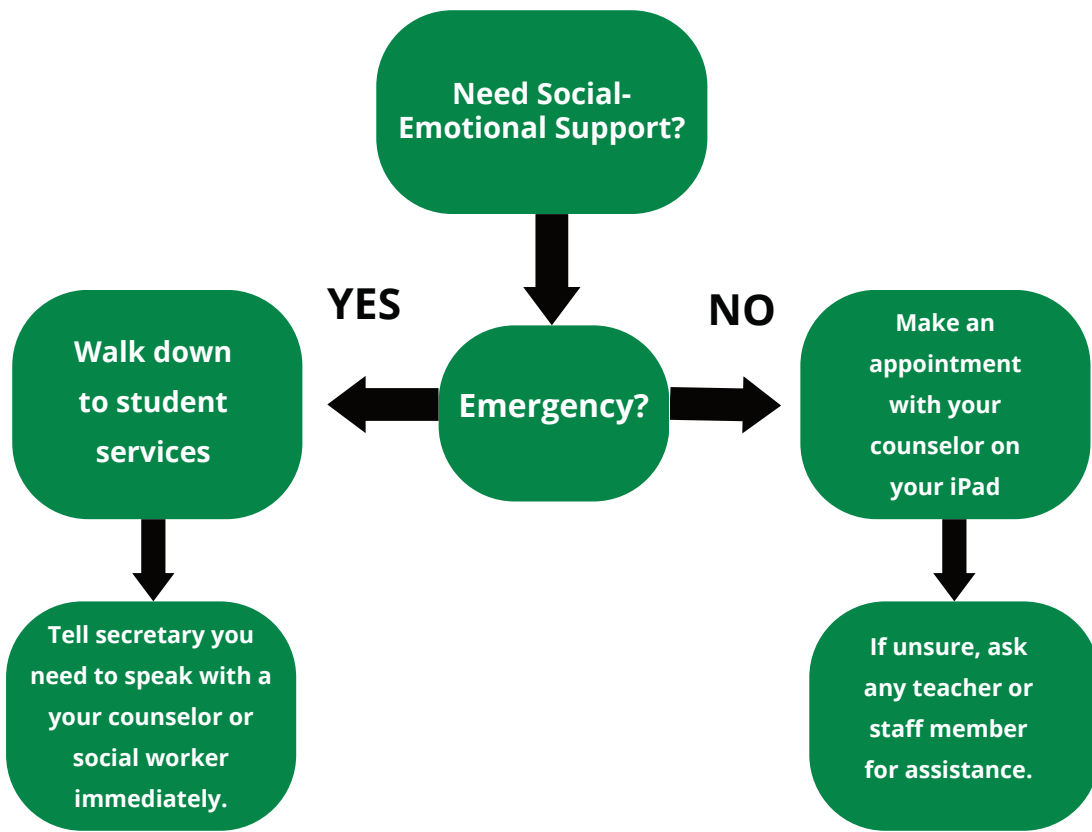
Site/App	Purpose
	Skyward is the district's student management system. It includes information like student and teacher scheduling, discipline, attendance, etc.
	Canvas is the district's online learning platform. It is the main tool used for teaching and learning at OLCHS.

School Counseling

College & Career Support

College & Career Counselor: Mrs. Kelly Kenny

Mrs. Kenny is located in the College and Career Center in the main hallway in the Student Services Office. She can advise students how to choose a postsecondary path that aligns their interests with schools that best fit their needs. Some of the events planned by Mrs. Kenny and the School Counselors include:

- **Open House**
 - Parents can receive information on college planning, trade schools, apprenticeship and the military. This occurs during the first quarter of each year.
- **College & Career Week**
 - Week in Mid-September featuring a number of activities highlighted by a fair to provide information to prospective students from over 50 colleges/universities and trades people.
- **Financial Aid Night**
 - Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) along with OLCCHS counselors give a presentation on financial literacy for college.
- **FAFSA Completion Workshops**
 - Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) along with OLCCHS counselors provide an overview of the FAFSA and give technical help to parents.
- **College 101 Night**
 - OLCCHS School Counselors provide an overview of the college application process and what should be prepared for and expected in your student's first years.

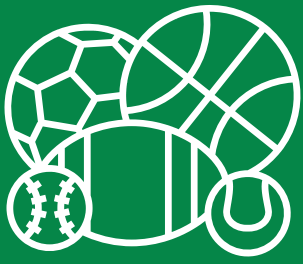
Health Services

The **OLCHS Health Team** is here to support students with a variety of needs including:

- **Not Feeling Well at School:** A student who is ill may obtain a pass from a teacher and go to the Health Office. If the student must be sent home, a parent/guardian, or another responsible adult, listed in the student's emergency contacts, in Skyward, must give permission through the Health Office for the student to leave school. No student who is ill may leave school without permission of the nurse.
- **Physicals:** To enroll at OLCHS, a physical examination must have been completed within twelve months of the first day of class on a State of Illinois **form**. Should the student participate in a sport, a sports physical is valid for 13 months from the date of the exam. Students should turn in all physicals, and sports physicals to the Health Office.
- **Vaccinations:** All students attending OLCHS, must be compliant with state regulations, and compliant with all required immunizations. Proof of vaccines should be given to the Health Office.
- **Other Info:** Over-the-counter medication (Tylenol, ibuprofen, or Tums) can be administered by the Nurse if both the parent and the primary care physician complete the required **form**. This form needs to be completed each year.
