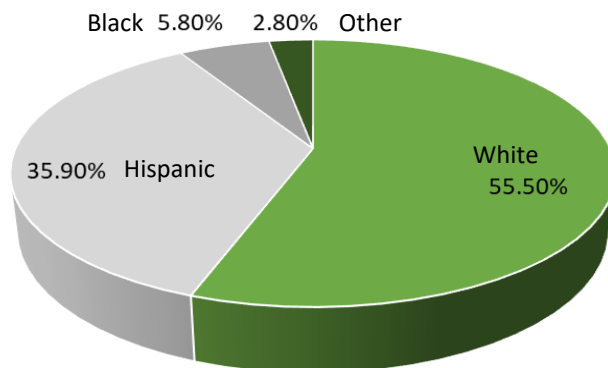

DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

District 229 serves a community composed of four towns and villages: Oak Lawn, Hometown, Chicago Ridge, and Bridgeview. The community is located on the southwest border of Chicago. Oak Lawn is a close-knit community and only minutes away from Chicago. Chicago Midway airport is three miles from Oak Lawn. Interstates 294, 55, and 57 provide easy access from north and south. District 229 is a one high school district.

OAK LAWN COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

Oak Lawn Community High School, which opened in 1955, is one of two public high schools located within the village of Oak Lawn. Of Oak Lawn's 1,815 students, 37% come from low-income families. Demographic makeup: White 55.5%, Hispanic 35.9%, Black 5.8%, and other 2%.

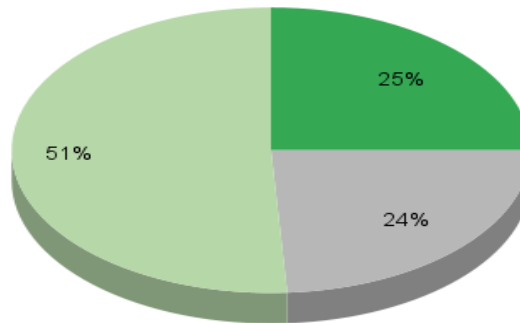
