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
DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

District 229 serves a community composed of four towns and villages: Oak Lawn, Hometown, Chicago Ridge, and Bridgeview. The community is located on the southwest border of Chicago. Oak Lawn is a close-knit community and only minutes away from Chicago. Chicago Midway airport is three miles from Oak Lawn. Interstates 294, 55, and 57 provide easy access from north and south. 
