

# Test Prep Resources

**GALE** - This free program provides resources and practice tests for AP Exams, ACT, SAT, and the ASVAB and customizes to your strengths and weaknesses. To access this, go to the Media Center link at the bottom of the OLCHS web page. Click on [online resources](#) and find the button on the bottom right labeled "Testing & Education Reference Center". The password is OLCHS. You will need to create a login and password your first time. We suggest using your ID number for your Login and Password. There are free online books that can be downloaded as well.

**Better Prep Success** - [Jason Franklin](#) is a former teacher and is now an ACT prep instructor. He has online video classes available to prepare students for both the ACT and SAT (available October 1, 2020). Costs range from \$199 (Basic Membership) to \$299 (Premium Membership).

**Khan Academy** - Offers free SAT practice tests online.

**Magoosh** - Offers over 140 video lessons, over 400 practice questions, an app with text reminders, and study schedules for the ACT and SAT. Costs vary, but are affordable.

**March2Success** - This is a free online prep course that offers 7 full-length practice ACT and SAT tests, as well as practice tests for the ASVAB. They show you what questions you got wrong and offer mini-lessons to help prepare for the official exam. Sponsored by the U.S. Army.

**Jeanius Prep** - Private and group ACT and SAT prep classes with a good track record typically held in Palos Heights and Mokena, IL, but being conducted via Zoom during COVID. Classes are two hours per week. Visit their website or contact Jeanine Pawelczyk at 815-474-4090 or Jeanne Bern at 708-389-6534 for detailed information. Costs range from \$200 - \$340.

**Higher Scores Test Prep** - Online ACT and SAT prep courses offered with customizable and flexible scheduling. \$187 for their quick prep course, or \$647 total for their complete package offering.

**ACT Academy** - Online personalized practice for the entire ACT or individual sections. Costs vary.

**SAT Study Guide** and **ACT Prep Guide** - These are books that includes practice tests, explanations for answers, test-taking strategies, and preparation techniques. Costs vary between \$25 - \$40.

**SAT** and **ACT Premium Prep books** - Published by the Princeton Review, these books contain 8 full length practice tests (4 in the book and 4 online) with drills, techniques, and score reports included. Access to online tools included with purchase. Costs range from \$25 - \$30
